ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current [AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure 5](#) and as per [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.03\(A\) SANCTIONING MATRIX \(A\)](#).

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20", 24", and Retro bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

RACE INFORMATION

RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing](#).

Rule 2.03.03a, will be applied for any competitor who does not start the final / last moto which means they will not qualify for event awards and series qualification rounds & points if applicable.

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Sprockets, Novice, and Challenge categories will be issued their awards on the day at the conclusion of the event.

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to info@nbmx.com.au.
